Business Activity Statement

If you are a business registered for GST you need to lodge a business activity statement (BAS). The **business activity statement** (BAS) is a form submitted to the Australian Taxation Office by all businesses to report their taxation obligations.

Your BAS will help you report and pay taxes such as:

- Goods and Services Tax (GST)
- Pay as you go instalments (PAYG)
- Pay as you go Withholding Tax (PAYGW)
- Fringe Benefits Tax (FBT)
- Wine Equalisation Tax (WET)
- Luxury Car Tax (LCT)
- Other taxes.
